# FROM A PROMISE TO A MOVEMENT

-A New Chapter in Rural Healthcare Begins



**When a Mobile Medical Van became a symbol of hope for the mountains of Kullu.**

"Some journeys begin on roads. Others begin with a promise."

On 9 July 2026, amidst the majestic mountains of Himachal Pradesh, the quiet village of Chansari witnessed a moment that will be remembered not merely as an inauguration, but as the beginning of a transformative journey towards equitable healthcare.



For generations, the people of Kullu's remote villages have faced immense challenges in accessing quality healthcare. Difficult terrain, limited connectivity, and long journeys to the nearest medical facility often meant that timely treatment remained out of reach. Recognizing this need, NHPC Limited, under its CSR initiative, partnered with Matrix Society for Social Services (MASS) to launch the Primary and Preventive Healthcare Services through Mobile Medical Van project—bringing quality healthcare directly to the doorsteps of those who need it most.



The inauguration ceremony, held in Chansari Village, marked the formal beginning of a healthcare initiative designed to serve some of the most remote communities of the district.



The occasion was graced by Hon'ble Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha, Mandi), Smt. Kangana Ranaut, whose presence added significance to an initiative dedicated to improving the lives of rural communities.

Joining the occasion were senior officials from NHPC Limited, including the General Manager, representatives of Matrix Society for Social Services, local dignitaries, public representatives, community leaders, and hundreds of enthusiastic villagers who gathered to witness this landmark moment.

Against the backdrop of the Himalayan landscape, the Mobile Medical Van stood not merely as a vehicle, but as a promise—a promise that quality healthcare would now travel where roads end and hope begins.

While the ribbon marked the official launch, the true celebration had already begun.

Alongside the inauguration, a comprehensive Health Camp was organised, bringing together the dedicated medical and field team of the project. Villagers received consultations, health screenings, medicines, and valuable health awareness, experiencing firsthand the services that the Mobile Medical Van will continue delivering across remote villages in the months ahead.

For many residents, it was their first opportunity to access quality healthcare without leaving their own community. Elderly citizens, women, children, and daily wage workers—all found care, guidance, and reassurance under one roof. The smiles on the faces of beneficiaries reflected something far greater than successful event management.

The Mobile Medical Van represents much more than a healthcare vehicle.

It is a fully equipped travelling healthcare unit designed to deliver essential medical consultations, basic diagnostics, medicines, preventive healthcare services, and health awareness programmes directly to villages where healthcare facilities remain limited.

Through this initiative, communities will no longer need to undertake exhausting journeys for basic healthcare services. Instead—

Healthcare will now make the journey for them.
